

MARATHON-RELAY REGISTRATION FORM 2011

1. Rules Marathon Relay 2011 (relay of 3 runners)

Article 1 – Organization

The second edition of 'Pi Marathon du Mans' is organized on 23 October 2011 by the association Philippidès & Co (FFA club), association law 1901, declared at the Prefecture of Sarthe under the n° W723002261 and affiliated to the FFA.

Article 2 – Circuit of the Pi Marathon (different to the individual MARATHON)

An exceptional running surface

The running circuit is based on the 'Grand Circuit des 24 Heures du Mans', and will be entirely closed to traffic.

The 42,195 kilometers circuit has been officially measured. It is composed of 3 identical laps of 14,065 KM of the 'Circuit des 24 Heures du Mans'. The runners complete one lap each (it is also possible to enter with only two runners, the 1st runner doing the 1st and 3rd lap). The start will be given at 9h15 am Sunday 23rd October 2011 on the 'Circuit des 24 Heures du Mans'. The arrival will be on the same circuit on the straight line of the stands. The participants will run on the prestigious 'Circuit des 24 Heures du Mans', especially opened for this occasion. The circuit can be seen on the website www.marathondumans.com. (Under reserve of eventual changes)

Article 3 – Inscriptions (caution, limited number of team)

The event is open to runners who are licensed or unlicensed, born before October 22, 1995. For minors, parental consent is necessary.

Registrations can be made by:

- The web site www.marathondumans.com
- Or by post, by filling in an official entry form

The name of the team is the name that will appear on the bibs. In the case of company category, please write the precise and complete name.

Registrations will not be accepted if one of the following parts is missing:

- Completed registration form, (with names and addresses of the 3 competitors of the team)
- Entry fees (by bank card for those inscribing by internet, or by check for those who send by post, written out to the association

Philippidès & Co)

- Medical certificate, stating no contraindication to the practice of competitive athletics and running signed and it has to be dated within the last year at the date of the race), or a copy of your valid sports license. This document has to be shown when collecting your running bib, (without it, your participation will be refused).

No inscriptions will be accepted on the day of the race or by telephone. We remind you that there will be different controls during the race to ensure the smooth running of the event. We remind you that all competitors participate at their own risk. All runners must present their licenses upon request or a medical certificate stating no contraindication to the practice of competitive running and athletics, and it has to be dated within the last year at the date of the race.

Important : if one of the three riders is unable to attend the D-Day, you can substitute him with another person. In this case, you just have to come with all documents concerning him at the withdraw of bibs numbers (ID card (or copy) + medical certificate or license)

CAUTION:

Following Circular No. 13 dated 21 April 2008, it is stated that the medical certificate must contain the words "no contraindication of the practise of competitive running" or "no contraindication to the practice of competitive athletics".

The licenses FFTRI, FSCF, FSGT and UFOLEP are accepted if they are showing exactly the word "athletics". Other licenses can not be accepted.

Article 4 – Engagement

The commitment allows each participant access to:

- The running bibs for the participation of the 3 members of the team
- Access to the mythical 'circuit des 24 Heures du Mans'.
- A parking place on the circuit
- 3 t-shirts « FINISHER »
- Refreshments and entertainment all along the race
- The timing will be measured for each member of the team.

Each team must choose a captain.

The inscription prices are:

- * January 1 to May 2 : 24 € per runner
- * May 3 to August 31 : 25 € per runner
- * September 1 to October 19 : 26 € per runner

Registration deadlines (**impossible to register after October the 19th**)

- * Until September 30 by mail
- * Until October 19th up to 8h pm by internet (secured CB)

Caution: entry fees of 5 € are offered for register online.

All entries are personal, fixed and can't be reimbursed for whatever reason, except for teams that have taken out "annulation", see article 17, inscriptions can't be transferred, in case of accident, the person having transferred his entry to a third person is responsible for him or her. The organizers decline all responsibility in case of accident in this situation. The running numbers must be visible and worn at all times. You will have the possibility to change your partner during the registration at Le Mans.

Article 5 – Running bibs

The running bibs can be withdrawn on Saturday 22 October from 2pm till 7pm or on Sunday 23rd October from 6am till 8am at MUSEE DE L'AUTOMOBILE (on the circuit of 24 Heures du Mans), by presenting the following :

- A proof of identity
- An up to date medical certificate or a copy of your license

The runner's bibs will be shown on the web site www.marathondumans.com and also sent by SMS. All allocated numbers cannot be changed, no numbers will be sent by post.

Article 6 – Accommodation

Article 7 – Official Jury

The official jury is made up of a judge referee, with the power and the decision of the final word. He is assisted by judges and race commissioners. Refreshment stands are installed every 5 kms and also at the arrival. Sponges are available every 5 km, from the 7,5km. The times will be shown at the arrival. The delay limit is 5h30, after that time, the runner's numbers will be taken. Any competitors wishing to continue after that time will be at his or her own risk, the organizers will not be held responsible in case of accident. The runner engages on his honor to complete the whole distance without shortcuts before reaching the finishing line. All runners must respect the Highway Code.

Article 8 – Relays zone

The passing of the relays will take place inside an area defined and delimited on the ground. A judge will be in charge of verifying the changeover of each person. The relays' stick will be marked with an electronic tag; every team will have one electronic tag, placed around the ankle.

Article 9 – The categories

- * Men (only men)
- * Women (only women)
- * Mixed (men and women)

Furthermore and in addition, you can check "company" if you run on behalf of your employer.

All three members must be present for the prize ceremony if they have won something, and for those who chose company category, present photocopy of salary or pay slip (front page only needed as proof)

Article 10 – TIMING

The timing of the event will be undertaken by an official timer recognized by FFA, using an electronic timer system. Each team will have 1 electronic tag or equivalent system. This electronic tag will be initialized automatically on the starting line and will be used to control the race on various points of the circuit. All runners not following the traced circuit will not be officially timed and not ranked at the arrival. The electronic tag or equivalent system will be recuperated by the organizers at the arrival. Any non-made chip will be charged 30 € by the timing company.

Article 11 – Security

The road security will be controlled by the police force aided by competent signaler, the Red Cross or equivalent organism will be posted on the circuit, first post at 12,5kms, then every 5kms, having the right to stop competitors suffering from medical disorders. All competitors deciding to continue do so at their own risk and the organizers will not be held responsible in case of accident.

Article 12 – Civil Responsibility

Conforming to the rules, the organizers have taken out an insurance covering their civil responsibilities, and for the participant's responsibilities in 'Marathon du Mans'. Documentary evidence can be given to participants on demand. Concerning the civil responsibility of the runners, the intervention of this insurance is limited to the accidents they can cause during the event. If the runners have another insurance or guarantee, the guarantee of the organizers will take place as a complement. The organizers advise all competitors to have their own personal insurance notably the non licensed runners.

Article 13 – Photo rights

Each participant when engaging, authorizes The 'association Philippiès & Co' to use all photos, to reproduce participants names, photos, voices, in any way or means in the context of sporting events throughout the world by means known or unknown within the date limit that has been accorded within the law, the decisions by law or by the referees of all the countries present or future of the international conventions present or future.

Article 14 –Traffic on the circuit

All bicycles, motorbikes, mopeds etc are forbidden on the circuit except for the officials.

Article 15 – Abandonment

Each participant wishing to stop the race must present himself to a feeding station or first aid post and give his number and chip. Any non-made chip will be charged 15 € by the timing company.

Article 16– Prizes / podium

The prize giving will take place on the circuit of '24 Heures du Mans' after the arrival. The 3 best teams of every category will be rewarded. The award of company "category" is combined with other categories, such as Men, Women and Mixed. Prizes will only be given to the competitors who are present except for competitors held for anti doping control.

Article 17 –Cancellation fee (optional)

A team may have to cancel registration in case of serious illness of a member, injury, a travel accident, death of spouse, his ascendants and / or its descendants. By accepting the cancellation fee, for 8 €, adding to the cost of registration, the team will receive a refund of registration for the race, on a contract basis on the amount of registration. In this sense, the proof has to be sent to the Marathon Le Mans before October 23, 2011 (postmark as proof), except for death. No refund can be claimed in case of failure to submit proof. The refund will be made after 23/10/2011.

ALL COMPETITORS MUST HAVE READ ALL THE INFORMATION AND AGREE TO ALL THE CLAUSES.
